Oregon HB 3075 should be opposed because, like Measure 114, it infringes upon the constitutional rights of law-abiding citizens. The bill fails to address the root causes of crime or improve public safety effectively. Instead, it creates a bureaucratic burden for law enforcement, diverting resources from addressing actual threats. This legislation criminalizes responsible gun owners while hindering their ability to protect themselves. Requiring a permit to exercise a constitutional right is an overreach. Ultimately, HB 3075, similar to Measure 114, strains law enforcement resources by forcing them to manage a permitting scheme that provides no tangible public safety benefit.
