Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I oppose House Bill 3075 (HB 3075) because it risks deepening systemic inequities and violating constitutional rights. The bill gives law enforcement too much discretion in permitting decisions, which could lead to biased outcomes that disproportionately impact marginalized communities. Its high fees create financial barriers for lower-income Oregonians, effectively limiting access to constitutional rights based on income. Additionally, retroactively criminalizing legally purchased firearm accessories is unfair and likely unconstitutional. This bill won't enhance public safety but will invite costly legal challenges and reinforce inequality. I urge a NO vote on HB 3075.
