I oppose this bill as it is a flagrant infringement of my second amendment rights. This bill creates a registry of only lawful firearms users and when similar laws have been applied in other states it has never proven that such laws have reduced crimes committed with firearms or prevented a suicide. Limitation on the number of rounds that a magazine can hold will do nothing to prevent a mass shooting. It will only infringe on lawful firearms users to engage in competitive shooting sports, training, and self defence against multiple aggressors. It would be better to legislate bills that would address those persons that unlawfully use a firearm in criminal acts. California once required a 5 year mandatory prison term for using a firearm in a crime, and that the full 5 years must be served. It was effective.
