Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

As a Democrat and socialist resident of Oregon for now 38 years, I oppose HB 3075 for its overreach on restrictions on firearms ownership. Providing more power to police and law enforcement on who is able to own firearms in Oregon will continue negative impact to marginalized and threatened communities.
