Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I opposed HB 3075 for the following reasons:

Second Amendment Violation: HB 3075's extended waiting periods, fees, and discretionary permitting likely violate the Bruen test by burdening the right to bear arms without historical precedent.

Ex Post Facto Clause: Retroactively criminalizing legally purchased magazines violates the U.S. and Oregon Constitutions' prohibition on ex post facto laws.

Due Process Concerns: The vague permit denial standard risks arbitrary enforcement, violating due process protections.

Equal Protection Issues: The bill could disproportionately affect lower-income and minority groups, violating the Equal Protection Clause.
