I appreciate the opportunity to testify today in support of HB 3568 - the Seafood to Schools Act.

I have been a resident of Tillamook County for the past 30 years. My home of 28 years is ¼ mile from the Pacific Ocean. I was surprised to learn recently that an overwhelming majority of seafood caught in Oregon waters is processed and shipped out of the state! Imagine, all of that high quality product being sent away while we import and eat lesser-quality seafood.

I support **HB 3568 – the Seafood to Schools Act** because I believe it will not only help feed our children a healthier, higher quality product, it will teach those same children the importance of locally sustainable fisheries while also providing a much-needed economic boost to our fishers - and hopefully stimulate more local seafood production and processing.
