We strongly ask you to oppose this bill for the above mentioned struggles that it will cause on our businesses and on the individuals that rely on our services.

We would gladly appreciate your reconsideration of Medicaid payments that are well below residents care needs and below market costs so we can focus on providing the best care services.

The daily stress of running a small business under fluctuating market that lately sees only rising costs prevents us from generating an adult care home for profit (as most Oregon regulated businesses with a profit margin of 45%). This would lead to more closed adult care homes and less Medicaid beds available to our communities.
