I oppose Ballot measure 114. Gun registration and gun owner licensing would NOT prevent or solve crimes. Most people sent to prison for gun crimes acquire guns from theft, the black market, or acquaintances. By passing Ballot measure 114 you are in fact criminalizing legal gun owners. This would make gun owners that possess magazines with a capacity larger than 10 rounds that were obtained legally now felons according to this bill. This bill requires "proof" of ownership of "high capacity" magazines prior to December, 2022. This grandfathering of this requirement is ludicrous.
