Dear Members of the committee,

I oppose HB3075 aka M114 with extreme prejudice. As descendant and survivor of a family member that was murdered by the Chinese Communist Party (CCP); HB3075 inches Oregonians and fellow Americans one step closer to Communism and confiscation.
