The first section of Oregon's Constitution states that:

We declare that all men, when they form a social compact are equal in right: that all power is inherent in the people, and all free governments are founded on their authority, and instituted for their peace, safety, and happiness; and they have at all times a right to alter, reform, or abolish the government in such manner as they may think proper.

As the Citizens of Oregon we have the inherent power and the Oregon government is found on our authority.

However this government continues to try and take our peace safety and happiness away from the citizens with your harsh laws and regulations which are repugnant to the Constitution of the United States of America.

The framers and founders of our Country ensured that Americans would always have the right to keep and bear arms. In fact at that time we had the right to have whatever weapons the government had without limitation.

And here we are standing in history at the time when Oregon legislators and rogue judges are poised to try and infringe on these rights.

The people of Oregon demand that our Constitutional Rights be observed and maintained as we strongly believe these rights are worth fighting for as of our forefathers and ancestors have.
