As an owner operator of an Adult Foster Care Home I oppose HB 3838 since I perceive it as an added financial burden to the current significant increase in prices on all expenses we face in running our business. We have a Medicaid contract and we serve up to 5 state paid clients. Most times we have 2 or more vacancies, and HB 3838 would make it impossible for us to afford relief caregivers because we would be required to pay the increased amount regardless whether we have 1-2 clients or 4-5 clients in the home. The rate we get paid per client by the state is not sustainable for us to afford the increase required under HB 3838.
