HB 3075 Robert Fujimoto

Hello, my name is Robert Fujimoto and I am here today to support Moms Demand Action for Gun Sense in America. Thanks to the work of Moms Demand Action and Students Demand Action volunteers from across our state, Oregon has become a leader in the fight to end gun violence. Yet there is still work to be done. I am here today to urge you to adopt HB 3075.

In 2022, voters passed Measure 114 because they understand Oregon needs common-sense gun safety policies. Measure 114 changed gun laws in Oregon to require a permit to purchase or acquire a firearm, and to ban the sale, transfer, and importation of magazines that "are capable of holding" more than ten rounds of ammunition.

Now that the law has been declared constitutional by a three-judge panel with the Oregon Court of Appeals, HB 3075 will ensure smooth implementation so that the system can get up and running as soon as possible. This bill will address a number of technical fixes to allow law enforcement to efficiently process gun purchase permits.

Oregon citizens voted for Measure 114 because it makes common sense to thoroughly vet gun purchasers, and it makes common sense to outlaw large-capacity magazines. Please vote for HB 3075.
