OTRADI is one of Oregon's Centers of Innovation Excellence. OTRADI is a non-profit institute funded primarily by the State of Oregon, under the umbrella of Business Oregon and the Oregon Innovation Council. OTRADI's mission is to fuel the economic development of Oregon's bioscience industry by enabling the translation of innovative research into products and companies that benefit human health and create high-wage jobs for Oregon.

The goal of Virogenomics BioDevelopment is to partner with academic researchers and help commercialize their ideas by providing grant writing and preliminary data/assay development support. We have been in business in Oregon for 10 years and have been awarded \$ 6.5 million in federal grant support. We are currently awaiting notice of award on a grant for \$15 million to advance a therapeutic for methamphetamine addiction and multiple sclerosis into a phase one clinical trial.

This work would not be possible without the support of OTRADI. Virogenomics BioDevelopment's laboratory is housed in the Oregon Bioscience Incubator space on Macadam Avenue in Portland. The space includes access to shared equipment that is essential for the data generated for this grant submission. Furthermore, the ability to interact with other companies in the incubator has fostered additional opportunities for product development. A collaboration that I am particularly interested in is one to generate an at home test to predict aortic aneurysm.
