Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

As a concerned Oregonian, I oppose HB3075 due to lack of a fiscal impact statement, having no clear estimate of the cost to taxpayers. This bill burdens law-abiding citizens by doubling permit fees and extending processing times while increasing demands on the Oregon State Police and staff. There is no clear fiscal analysis of this expanded bureaucracy, though we can expect higher administrative costs, more staffing time, and no evidence these changes will impact safety. Responsible legislation requires transparency, yet HB3075 will create unaccountable spending as well as punishing law-abiding citizens.
