To the Members of the Oregon House Judiciary Committee,

Please consider my strong opposition to HB 3075.

1. If agencies cannot determine in 30 days whether or not someone is unqualified to own a firearm, there is a problem with the agencies and the system. This is an unjustified infringement of our right to bear arms.
