

President Peters Testimony on SCR 10 Monday March 17th, 2025

Chair Jama, Vice-Chair Bonham and members of the committee,

For the record my name is Dr. Jesse Peters and I serve as the President of Western Oregon University. Thank you for the opportunity to submit testimony in support of passage of SCR 10.

About eight months after I became president of Western Oregon University, Peter Courtney came to campus to meet with me. People had warned me that Peter could be "challenging" at times, so I didn't quite know what to expect. He came in full of personality and conversation, and I could tell he had a great affinity for my Executive Assistant, LouAnn Vickers, whom he worked with for so many years. Shortly after we sat down, we started swapping stories about growing up; I told him about the farm in Georgia, and he spoke of West Virginia. From what I hear, people owe a lot to Peter Courtney. Even though my time with him was just a fleeting moment, I feel like I owe a lot to him too. So, Peter, you can count on us, by god, to keep on serving our students and the state of Oregon in the very best ways we can. Thanks for all you did.
