We have to be able to protect ourselves, our staff as well as our other students when a student is so dis regulated they are causing harm. Restraint is a last resort in all cases but the threat of child abuse charges hinders our ability to provide safety for all students.

Please support Bill HB 3835 and support your teachers in what is a very tough and necessary job.
