Oregon House Bill 3075 aims to enhance public safety by strengthening firearm regulations in the state. The bill extends the background check period from 30 to 60 days, allowing for more thorough vetting of permit applicants. It also requires applicants to complete a firearms safety training course within five years prior to applying for a permit, ensuring that gun owners are well-educated on proper handling and safety protocols.
