I oppose bill 3076 as it is continuing to add to regulations already in place for gun sales. This will add an additional burden to all gun dealers who will have to now have state licensing as well as federal licensing to sell firearms, leading to further restrictions to 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment rights. This is more of a control and harassment to gun dealers and does not offer any protections to our gun rights. This is a gateway to more gun control that the people have proved they do not want.

Bill 114 was marketed to people as a better background checks but this is simply untrue. This bill was passed as a way for gun control that the people do not actually want, bill 3076 continues along the same premise as an amendment bill. The Oregon firearms safety act of 2015 SB 941 already makes the sale/transfer of firearms between non related private parties illegal, even before then in gun shows around Oregon had to have background checks dealers or private party since 2000 and we have had background checks for dealer sales in place from 1989.

This bill 3076 has no fiscal impact statement, which means there is no budget for either bill regulations to be put in effect, and there is also no licensing system set up to take over the need that bill 114 creates and bill 3076 does not solve. This is an immediate infringement on 2<sup>nd</sup> amendment rights as we will not be able to purchase firearms if they're put into place.

I highly encourage this bill is not passed as it is an infringement on everyone's rights as US citizens.
