I am testifying in opposition to SB 634. Adding existing large hydropower to the list of renewables eligible for RPS (renewable portfolio standards) credit would dramatically slow the growth of clean energy generation in Oregon. It would allow utilities to meet their RPS requirements without adding new clean generation which would entirely defeat the purpose of the RPS. It would also jeopardize meeting our important HB 2021 goals.
