This is my written testimony in opposition HB3075

To whom it may concern,

3. **\*Increased Costs for Law-Abiding Citizens:\*** Stricter gun control measures could lead to increased costs for law-abiding citizens, including the costs of compliance with new regulations, increased prices for firearms and ammunition, and potential fees associated with background checks and licensing requirements.
4. **\*Negative Impact on Rural Economies:\*** The firearms industry is a significant contributor to rural economies, with many manufacturers and distributors located in rural areas. Reduced demand for firearms could have a disproportionate impact on rural economies, exacerbating existing economic challenges.

**\*Conclusion:\***

While the debate over gun control is complex and multifaceted, our analysis suggests that stricter gun control measures could have significant adverse effects on the

economy. Policymakers should carefully consider these potential impacts when evaluating proposed gun control legislation.

**\*Recommendations:\***
