Dear Members of the House Committee On Judiciary,

I'm writing in strong opposition to HB 3076. Like many recent gun control measures, HB 3076 targets responsible gun owners and dealers while doing nothing to stop criminals. Oregon has already seen the passage of Measure 114, a deeply flawed and unconstitutional law that imposed magazine bans and permit-to-purchase requirements, restricting the rights of law-abiding citizens while criminals continue to ignore the law.

By adding unnecessary licensing requirements, HB 3076 could force small, family-run firearm dealers out of business, leaving Oregonians with fewer options to legally purchase firearms. This does nothing to reduce crime—it only makes it harder for responsible citizens to make legal purchases and for small business owners to make a living.
