Oregon Measure 114 imposes extreme restrictions on law-abiding gun owners while doing little to prevent crime. The measure's permit-to-purchase requirement creates unnecessary bureaucratic hurdles, disproportionately affecting responsible citizens while failing to address the root causes of violence. Additionally, the restrictions on magazine capacity infringe on Second Amendment rights without clear evidence of improving public safety. Instead of burdening lawful gun owners, policymakers should focus on enforcing existing laws and addressing mental health and crime prevention. Measure 114 is an ineffective overreach that punishes responsible Oregonians rather than targeting criminals.
