Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3075

I oppose HB 3075 on numerous fronts. Firstly, the bill will only inconvenience law abiding gun owners(such as myself). As the criminally inclined; many of whom already are not able to legally own firearms, will make no effort to comply.

Secondly, this bill puts extra financial burden on gun owners. Besides the application fees for the special licensing and class fees, the law compliant magazines are expensive. Not to mention the possibility of needing a whole new firearm in order to comply.

Thirdly, as a taxpayer I am concerned about the cost of implementing and enforcing this bill. HB 3075 does not contain a fiscal impact statement. With needs for higher staffing for implementation and enforcement, of our already underfunded and understaffed police departments.
