I oppose this bill on a number of simple grounds. There is no emergency that warrants the immediate adoption. There has been no statement concerning the fiscal impact it would have. Requiring any opposition to the bill be filed in Marion County is an unreasonable especially since it would effect all residents of Oregon in all counties. It would unduly and unjustly prevent law-abiding Oregonians from utilizing already legally obtained and held property. There is no factual evidence that arbitrary limits on magazine capacity have any impact on public safety. Criminals who would endanger public safety will not adhere to this law. The bill will create an elite exempt class in military and law enforcement personnel.
