It covers the basics, but the property taxes keep creeping up. Last year, I had to dip into savings just to pay them, and I worry about how long we can keep that up. I don't want to leave our home—it's where I feel settled and safe.

HB 3755 would give us some relief. A tax exemption for those 65 and older would take a little weight off our shoulders. It's not a big ask, just enough to help us stay put without stretching ourselves too thin. I know the state has to manage its budget, but I think this could be a fair way to support seniors who've paid their dues.
