I strongly oppose HB 3075. The proposed legislation only seeks to eliminate the rights of dutiful and lawful Oregonians. You will disenfranchise the very people you represent, and in doing so criminalize a great portion of your constituents.

The clause to only allow challenges to this law in a single court in a single county is tantamount to defrauding law-abiding Oregonian of their rights to due process. Your choice of providing permits via police approval through a yet undetermined system means that you are making it relatively easier to acquire a gun in an illegal manner.

This bill comes at a time when your constituents are afraid to walk down the streets in urban areas, and your legislators have been allowed to concealed carry while on the job. Preventing responsible citizens from obtaining personal protection in a reasonable manner is a violation of the Second Amendment and an encouragement to bypass your law.

Please refrain from voting in favor of yet another law which will cost the taxpayers money in court to fight the impending appeals, and deal yet another blow to the safety and security of the people you purport to serve.
