As a school nurse overseeing 5 Social-Emotional Learning sites, safety is a huge issues not just for me but for staff, students and parents/guardians. We are often not having the privilege to know when new concussions or restrictions students may have after they are either sent out to be ruled out for concussions/injuries OR when they encountered new injuries outside of school but have seen medical providers. Without those information, we all are at risk of either "re-injuring" or pose other harm to students. Students with history of concussion whether it is new or old are often overlooked by non-medical person at school who are inputting health record or intake. Those non-medical persons do not have the skill to recognize the needs for IEP/504 or requesting accomodation thus leaving the students at risk for failure at school. I support the need for HB 3007 bill to pass to support thev students' success, safety and happiness.
