This bill would improve our state's rent stabilization statutes and prohibit the use of price-fixing

Too many Oregonians already struggle to find affordable housing before the additional burden of annual rent increases that far outpace average wage increases. The CAT renter's assistance staff helped me when I was being discriminated against for being a voucher recipient, a houshold of color and one with a person with disabilies. The property managment was intent on displacing us and making our lives while living in their complex as difficult as possible and whilst doing that not informing us of HUD required notifications of pur housing and civil rights in certain processes. It is critical to make changes to housing and rental laws including stable pricing and technology to safeguard renters, including vulnerable populations such as marganilized groups, seniors, those with language barriers and intellectually deficient renters.

I urge you to pass SB 722 to ensure that Oregonians are protected from unfair rental increases and price-fixing tools.
