Chair Kropf, Vice-Chairs Chotzen and Wallan, and members of the committee:

My name is Chad Stoll. I am a life long registered democrat. I have also owned and used firearms the majority of my life. I also support evidence-based solutions to gun violence that do not unduly restrict rights to ownership and use of firearms. I would like to voice my opposition to this bill.

As a parent I am very concerned with gun safety. I am also the parent of a son who would be considered marginalized. These are my largest concerns with this bill. It is pushed as gun safety. There is nothing in this bill making anyone safer. Evidence based gun safety would be making safe storage accessible such as a tax credit for gun safes. Another legitimate safety plan would be allowing an escrow program through an FFL where people can easily remove firearms from their home to prevent suicide or unwanted access.

As far as marginalized communities this bill still places the permitting process under law enforcement. I am highly opposed marginalized people having to ask permission from an agency that to say the least does not follow the beliefs and ethics of the Democratic Party. Nobody should be asking permission for something that is a right from somebody that is opposed to their existence.

I urge you to please oppose this legislation.
