Opposition Statement for HB3166

I strongly oppose HB3166, which seeks to implement ranked-choice voting in Oregon. This is nothing more than an attempt to override the will of the people. Oregonians have already voted against ranked-choice voting, making it clear that this is not the system they want. Instead of respecting that decision, HB3166 is simply a way to force through a policy that voters have already rejected.

Ranked-choice voting is a confusing and unnecessary system that complicates elections, leads to voter disenfranchisement, and often results in winners who do not have true majority support.
