I am a Federal Firearm Licensed Dealer in Oregon and started my business just over a year ago. I 100% love what I do working the front lines and helping people. In my line of work it's my job to qualify the buyer and run background checks before transferring the firearm. I've had denied applicants, delayed, and mostly approved background checks. I've also recovered stolen guns through the background check process and returned them to their owners.

THIS BILL WON'T ACCOMPLISH A REDUCTION IN GUN VIOLENCE, IT WILL INCREASE IT. We need more FFL's working these front lines assisting law enforcement. WHAT THIS BILL WILL ACCOMPLISH IS FFL DEALERS CLOSING THEIR BUSINESSES; especially home based dealers, which is the large majority of Gun Dealers. Less front line workers means more gun violence.

The goal of this bill including measure 114 is to make it more expensive to run a gun business and more expensive and difficult to buy a gun, in turn inhibiting gun sales with the hope of reducing gun violence. Criminals steal their guns or use ghost guns. Criminals don't care about laws or magazine capacity limits. The only people this is targeting is legitimate FFL dealers and legitimate gun owners.
