

OPA Supports House Bill 2387

The Oregon Psychological Association (OPA) is a professional association comprised of psychologists and associates who advocate for psychology on local, state, and national issues affecting both the profession and those we serve.

HB 2387 clarifies earlier legislation (ORS 475A.220-ORS 475A626 and ORS 676.177 which created laws and regulations for the use of psilocybin treatment in mental health.

- 1. Allows licensed health care providers, including psychologists, to discuss and provide psilocybin services.
- 2. Prevents healthcare regulatory boards, including OBOP from disciplining licenses for providing the above services.
- 3. Realigns the Oregon Psilocybin Advisory Board by limiting board membership to 9, including a psychologist among other health care providers.
- 4. Clarifies investigatory and information sharing processes of healthcare regulatory boards, including OPOB.
