Measure, Appointment or Topic: HB3076

I oppose HB3076, or any additional gun legislation, including requirements for additional dealer licensing, gun licensing whether applicable to gun dealers, parts dealers or gun owners. This is just another attempt and attack on Oregon gun owners, to erode our rights and find ways to prevent Oregonians from using those protected rights. This bill is another attempt at gun control for law abiding, legal gun owners that are of no threat to anyone. Dealers are already heavily scrutinized, taxed and further requirements are only meant to push dealers and gun owners out of Oregon and prevent them from purchasing, owning, using and enjoying guns, parts or ammunition.
