Again, while I am all for fiscal, conscious behavior in our state, and I think it is fair to validate that each child is yearly still in the home that they are contracted in, I do not believe that the agency has the ability to handle the bookkeeping necessary if this bill is requiring Receipts for every dollar spent. Again, I would need clarification to speak further, but there are a lot of logistics. I think they are being ignored.
