SUBJECT: Opposition to HB 3166

I am writing to express my opposition to HB 3166, which proposes to establish open primaries and ranked-choice voting.

In a state that is already dominated by a supermajority of democrats, I believe the result of open primaries would decrease the choices voters have in choosing elected representatives.

Section 40 of HB 3166 is especially problematic in that it would implement ranked-choice voting. This is an egregious affront to Oregon voters who overwhelmingly voted down ranked-choice voting in Measure 117 in 2024 by 57.7% to 42.3% (Ballotpedia).

In addition, ranked-choice voting is complicated and expensive, and will delay reporting the results.

Ranked-choice voting would also diminish voter confidence in elections because ballots can end up being "exhausted" – and trashed – and then not counted at all. This method completely ignores voters' preferences, eliminating a preferred candidate who would have led with the most votes received, but did not get a majority.

Ranked-choice voting would be a violation of the longstanding democratic representative principle of one person, one vote.

I strongly urge a NO vote on HB 3166.
