I am writing in support of SB 1076. I moved here from Colorado where we had a similar bill - called PACFA (Pet Animal Care and Facilities Act). Colorado has fewer puppy mills and pet stores that sell puppies than states that do not have this kind of law. Puppy mills are horribly cruel places where dogs suffer greatly and ALL puppies in pet stores come from puppy mills. In Colorado I worked at a large animal shelter where pets had to be euthanized - for medical and behavioral reasons and also because of time and space limitations.
