Federal officials who regulate firearms are only inspecting a small fraction of gun dealers in Oregon, records show.

The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives aim to inspect every gun dealer in the US every three years. But records show that in 2022 and 2023, the agency inspected just 31 and 34 of Oregon's roughly 2,000 firearms dealers – less than 2%.
