Testimony in Support of SB 537

Chair Patterson, Vice Chair Hayden, and members of the committee, I AM A PEGISTERED NURSE AT UNITY CENTER FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH IN PORTLAND. I LIVE IN PEDLAND, OR UNITY PROUDES ACUTE PSYCHIATRIC CARE & STABILIZATION FOR INDIVIDUALS EXPERIENCING A MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS IN THE METRO AREA, PRIOR TO UNITY, I WORKED AS AN ONLOLOGY NURSE, BOTH POLES HAVE THEIR REWARDS & CHALLENGES. NO MATTER THE CHALLENGES, VIOLENCE SHOULD NOT BE A PART OF A NURSE'S WORKDAY. I AM HERE TO SPEAK IN SUPPORT OF SB 537 TO PREVENT WORKPLACE VIOLENCE IN THE WORKPLACE. I HAVE EXPERIENCED VERBAL & PHYSICAL ASSAULTS - FROM HAVING A BUCKET OF EMESIS THROWN ON ME TO MULTIPLE PUNCHES TO MY HEAD BY A PATIENT, TRATHER THAN LEAVE THE HOSPITAL, OR THE PROFESSION, I CHOSE TO ENGAGE WITH THE SYSTEM TO CREATE SAFER WORK SPACES FOR MYSELF AND MY PEERS. I HAVE BEEN ON THE SAFETY COMMITTEE FOR YEARS, THIS EXPERIENCE HAS BEEN ETE OPENING AND SHOCKING, AT UNITY, OVER THE PAST YEAR. STAFF HAVE BEEN ASSAULTED HUNDREDS OF TIMES. FOR EXAMPLE, IN JUNE OF LAST SUMMER, STAFF WERE ASSAULTES 62 TIMES. MOST OF THOSE EVENTS DID NOT PESULT IN PHTSICAL INJURY BUT, YOU CAN IMAGINE, THE PSYCHOLOGICAL IMPACT CAN BE SIGNIFICANT AND LONG-LASTING. IT IS ALSO IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT FOUR (4) OF THOSE 62 ASSAULTS IN A SINGLE MONTH RESULTED IN PERMANENT DAMKGE. ACTUAL NUMBERS CHANGE FROM MONTH TO MONTH BUT ONE POINT IS EXTREMELY CLEAR - HEALTHCARE WORKERS COME TO WORK EACH DAY OR NIGHT TO EXPERIENCE VIOLENCE, OR THE THREAT OF VIOLENCE. WE NEED TO BO BETTER WHEN IT COMES TO PROTECTING THE PEOPLE WHO ARE PROVIDING CAPE TO OUR MOST VULNERABLE POPULATIONS. MY ASK IS THAT YOU SUPPORT SB537 TO STOP WORKPLACE VIOLENCE IN HEALTHCARE.
