this bill puts undue stress and expenses on firearm retailers that are law abiding both federally and state compliant. already get inspected from atf annually. We report multiple sales of 2 or more handguns to atf and local law enforcement which is required. we already have federal firearms license, federal tax license, state buisness license and city licensing and permits. the state is asking us to continue to provide safe and effective screening by conducting background checks on all sales like we have since 1989 which are handled by oregon state police to make sure that criminals are not receiving firearms and straw purchases dont happen but at the same time the state wants to charge all these fees and implement all these absurd requirements

All FFLs will be forced to have 24/7 live video and audio recording in their buisnesses whether they are brick and mortar or home based. Also including severe security measures on all doors and windows regardless of where firearms are kept
