Oregon is one of seven states that allow non-legislative entities and unelected bureaucrats to draft Bill measures. Oregon is the only State that allows them to directly introduce bills without a Legislative member. According to the National Conference of State Legislatures, 40 states specifically prohibit it. In this legislative session alone, 266 bills have been introduced by the state's executive and judicial branches—a number significantly higher than the bills introduced by most individual legislators.

SB 1006 would strengthen accountability, transparency, and the fundamental principles of representative government.
