I support SJR 28 "Right To a Healthy Environment" because it is critical to the financial health of the Oregon economy. For example, a healthy environment is the foundation of the travel industry in Oregon. Outdoor recreationists spent \$15.6 billion in 2019 in Oregon, supporting 224,000 full and part time jobs. Oregon's clean and healthy environment attracts visitors and new residents alike, thereby providing a source of skilled work force to support Oregon businesses and the economic growth provided by them.
