I am writing to express my opposition to HB 3076, as it would impose a significant financial burden and operational challenges on my business. I am a single mother, and I founded a cerakoting business last year. According to the ATF, this is considered a manufacturing activity, and to comply with local regulations, I had to obtain my Type 07 FFL.

I operate as a home-based FFL and am concerned that the substantial cost of installing the necessary security measures to meet the compliance requirements would be prohibitive. This financial strain would likely cause me to have to relinquish my license, which would negatively impact my business and jeopardize the stability of my family.

I believe that an exception should be made for home-based FFLs who mainly engage in manufacturing or gunsmithing activities. I should not be required to implement the same level of security measures as a store front business.
