If Alastairs caregivers, aren't trained enough, he could die. So instead I do it all myself. Without pay. I can't work. Despite this being my actual field of employment. Because I'm too busy providing these services for free to my own children. That might sound cold.

But I have a degree from Portland State University and student loans going unpaid every year. When I am using my education. I'm providing the support to my child needs to save his life and keep him safe daily.

Like any other parent, if you can't find somebody to do it you end up doing it yourself. We have hundreds of care. Attended hours go wasted every month. Please fund this. We were told this was going to be the thing that kept us from poverty. And instead things just keep getting harder and harder. Please keep your promise to Oregon. Oregon. These are our children. Please.
