This bill would place financial and regulatory burdens on firearm dealers for lawful purchasers, not criminals who are the issue here. The requirements for security and storage to operate would make it impractical for a small business to continue. This bill also grants the DOJ officials broad authority to conduct inspections of firearm businesses without probable cause or a warrant.
