Chair Lively and members of the House Committee on Climate, Energy and Environment:

I have just reviewed the submissions opposing HB3932. I note that of the 25 such contributions, some 14 are the same letter, some 8 are the same different letter, one contribution designated as opposing actually supports and a scant two are different from the two form letters that were clearly circulated among a community of individuals committed to trapping beaver. The two main letters both seemed to miss the point that this is not a general ban but a targeted control effort. Meanwhile none of these opposing contributions included any cited evidence to support the points that they used to bolster their position.

It is critical to do more than count the numbers. I hope the committee does more.
