Re: Support of Senate Bill 1153 (Safeguarding Stream Flows in Water Right Transfers)

Dear Chair Golden, Vice-Chair Nash, and Members of the Committee,

Trout Unlimited (TU) is a national organization dedicated to caring for rivers and streams so our children can experience the joy of wild and native trout and salmon. Our chapter of Trout Unlimited, the Bluebacks, has several hundred members in the Mid-Willamette Valley from Salem to Eugene, and from the Cascades to the ocean. As volunteers we conduct anadromous fish surveys on the North Santiam and the Luckiamute Rivers, monitor water chemistry in Corvallis area streams, annually clean trash from the South Santiam River, and participate in youth education about salmonids (i.e., Linn-Benton Salmon Watch, Clackamas Chapter Youth Flyfishing Camps).

The Blueback Chapter of Trout Unlimited SUPPORTS Senate Bill 1153.

This bill helps to ensure that water management doesn't degrade fish or water quality. SB 1153 is a reasonable and overdue update to the state's water laws as it would close a loophole in existing laws that could allow dewatering of waters that are important for fish survival. Passage of the law would protect Oregon's streams by setting a standard whereby streamflow diminishment would not be permitted in the state's transfer review statutes. As more transfer applications are received by the state in coming years this rule would protect fish, water quality, wildlife, recreation and cultural values that we and other Oregonians value.
