This Grant program provides funding for food producers to access necessary equipment to meet the demands of the school marketplace.

Food Roots connects local producers and local schools, providing procurement assistance, and invoicing and delivery services. I support this grant program because there is a significant need for Oregon-based food producers to be equipped to meet the growing demand from schools for local products. Schools and child care centers have specific requirements for products in regards to quantities, delivery, storage, and food safety. This ODA funding is critical for small-to-medium-scale producers who follow ethical and environmentally sustainable farming and processing practices to be able to scale to provide the quantities needed by the schools. Local farms are a vital resource in geographically isolated and rural regions such as Tillamook County.
