The Farm to School Equipment and Infrastructure Grant helps bridge this gap, ensuring that local producers can continue supplying fresh, high-quality food to Oregon schools.

I urge you to support this grant program in the Oregon Department of Agriculture's budget at \$1 million. Thank you for your time and for your commitment to strengthening local food systems.
