I oppose this proposal. These decisions, whether statutory, regulatory, or organizational, should be evidence based and include consideration of unintended consequences. The process to determine success of the proposal, with measurable objectives, is not clearly defined. Seemingly good intentions should not outweigh that of science, and guidance by qualified experts in their field at ODFW. The competence of ODFW is being challenged with no risk analysis provided or impact to interested parties statement.
